FOLLOW UP QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. Refresher..... How should we understand the Song of Songs? Is it love poetry? An allegory purely about God? How does it speak to us both about intimate human relationships and about the love between Christ and his Church?
2. Phil Ryken says "Spiritually speaking, most of us live as if we were single rather than married. Married people always have to give some consideration to their spouses, whereas single people have much more control of their time, their money, and their life decisions, both big and small. Unfortunately, this is the way that many of us operate spiritually. Occasionally we remember that we are betrothed to Jesus Christ, the Bridegroom of heaven. But most of the time we operate independently". In what ways is this true in your life? What might need to change? How will you pray for the Lords help?
3. What does the woman appreciate in her man? How does this both endorse and challenge typical male/female stereotypes and roles? How does the strength of the man point us to the man we all need - Christ?
4. What do you find helpful of challenging about the warning in v7?
