## FOLLOW UP QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. Read 2.8-13. (If you're married) is the desire to spend quality time with your spouse diminished? What might you do to rekindle this sense of companionship? (For all of us) To what extent are you comfortable using this kind of 'love language' to speak about your relationship with the Lord? DO you appreciate (and feel) his love for you? Are you responding with love and devotion?
2. Why does the man speak of his love being (as yet) 'hidden in places on the mountainside' (2:13). How does this relate to her instruction to him to 'turn away' (v17) and the warning she repeats (3:5)?
3. What do the foxes symbolize? (2:15)
4. What 'little foxes' are you encountering in your relationship with the Lord (or with your husband/wife if you are married)?
5. What might you do to tackle these problems?
